**VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT TO RESIGN FROM
JUDICIAL OFFICE IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

This Agreement is being entered into by the undersigned parties pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code.

WHEREAS on June 17, 2005, a complaint was filed with the Commission by the Sherman County Judge Carter alleging that Judge Lomax failed to follow proper court procedures on several occasions, and failed to complete her mandatory hours of judicial education, and

WHEREAS at all times relevant hereto, the Honorable Amanda Lomax was the Justice of the Peace in Precinct 3 for the City of Texhoma in Sherman County, Texas, and

WHEREAS no Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law have been made in connection with the above-referenced matters, and

WHEREAS the parties agree that the allegations of judicial misconduct, if found to be true, could result in further disciplinary action against Judge Lomax, and

WHEREAS the parties to this Agreement are desirous of resolving these matters without the time and expense of further disciplinary proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that Judge Lomax, upon the signing of this Agreement, shall resign her judicial office in lieu of disciplinary action by the Commission, pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code. The Commission agrees that it shall pursue no further disciplinary proceedings against Judge Lomax in connection with the above-referenced matters.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that, upon the Commission's approval of this Agreement, Judge Lomax shall be disqualified in the future from: sitting or serving as a judge in the State of Texas; standing for election or appointment to judicial office in the State of Texas; or performing or exercising any judicial duties or functions of a judicial officer in the State of Texas, including the performance of wedding ceremonies.
